A Datathon is a time-bound contest where teams of data experts collaborate to solve real-world problems using data-driven approaches. The aim is to craft inventive solutions by analyzing provided datasets. This event encourages enthusiastic students and researchers to apply their expertise to practical challenges.

Participation Guidelines:

- The competition is open to all students, researchers, and professionals who are interested in data science.
- Each team can have min of 1 and max of 3 people.

Structures:

- Datasets will be given on the day of competition.
- You must upload your notebooks for final review and validation. Ensure your code reproduces the same results every time it is run, and you must be able to display this as and when asked to present.
- All participants must submit a one-page report describing their approach and explaining the intuition (please don't throw any rocks at me) behind their model and the code (make sure that it can run on a GPU). Evaluation criteria will be RMS error and the quality of explanation provided
